



**Huub H.M. Rijnaarts** (1957) studied Environmental Sciences at Wageningen University, and received a PhD (1994) through his research on Microbial adhesion on solid surfaces and biodegradation of halogenated compounds in groundwater and soils, which he conducted at Wageningen University. He has built up and has lead applied research groups on Environmental Biotechnology for cleaning water, groundwater, and sediments at TNO and Deltares, the Netherlands, between 1994 and 2009. He was scientific director of TNO-WU joined research initiative on groundwater bioremediation from 1995-2005, supporting 20 PhD and postdocs. Since 2009 he is professor in Environmental Water Technology at the

sub-department of Environmental Technology of Wageningen University, and Scientific Chairman of the international conference AquaConSoil. He is member of the science board of Deltares, partner professor in TTI WETSUS. Since 2012 he is director of the Wageningen institute for Environmental and Climate research (WIMEK) which is part of the national graduate school SENSE (Socio-Economic and Natural Sciences of the Environment).
